## **GRAVE SITE DEDICATION**

The Chapter dedicated the grave site of Dr. Philip Thomas on Sunday, June 26, 2011 in the Mt. Olivet Cemetery. Dr. Thomas was born on June 11, 1747 and died April 26, 1815. He took up his medical practice in Frederick as the County's first physician on August 1, 1769. When the War of the American Revolution began, he was elected Captain of several local Militia Companies on November 20, 1775 and Colonel of the 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion on March 2, 1776. Doctor Thomas provided services to the cause on several

occasions. He was the son-in-law of John Hanson. This was a well attended event with many DAR and Chapter members in attendance.
